Shared Decision Making in the ICU – Prognosis and Uncertainty

Dr. Greenberg completed his medical training at Northwestern University in Chicago, followed by a residency in Internal Medicine at Emory University in Atlanta. He then pursued fellowship training in Pulmonary Critical care at the University of Chicago. In 2015, he joined the faculty at Rush, where he is Associate Professor of Internal Medicine in the Division of Pulmonary, Critical Care Medicine and Sleep Medicine. His research focuses on novel ways to communicate with and support families of critically ill patients, shared decision making in the ICU, and long-term outcomes for patients and families after critical illness.
